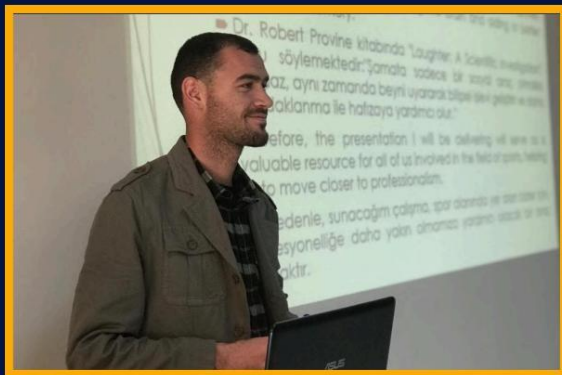

Participants had the opportunity to benefit from the experiences of professionals in the field and discuss ideas for improving the learning process in higher education.

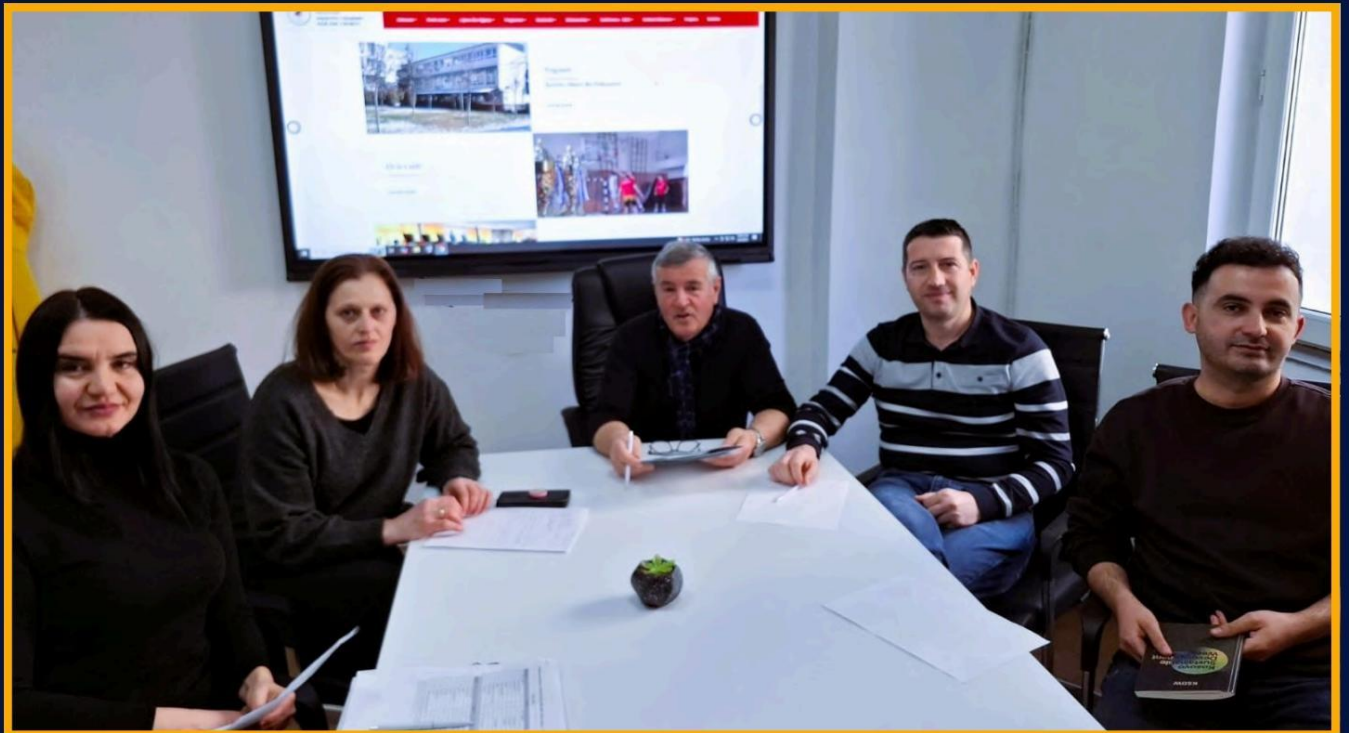
At the conclusion of the training, participants were provided with certificates, as proof of their commitment and dedication to advancing teaching methods.

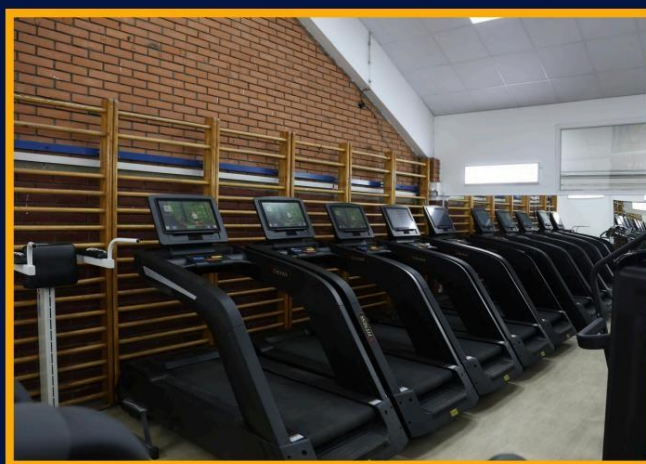


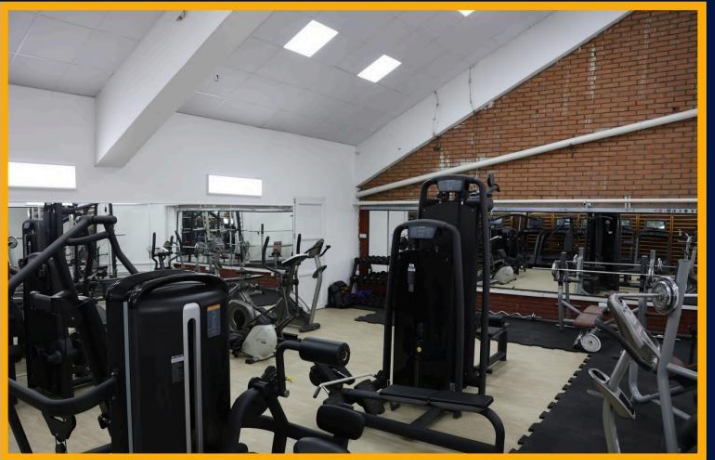

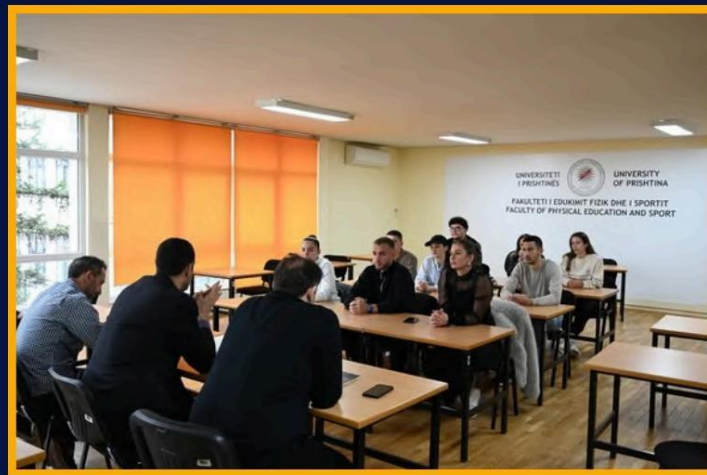
